1. Needle stick injuries are increasing in student (MBBS / Intern/ Nursing Student there in urgent need of Training of all newly Health care workers (PGI/MBBS/ Intern / all staff). (Action taken by Sr. Medical Superintendent / Nursing Superintendent)
2. Vaccination of health care workers against HBV is zero; we can take HBV from NHM under hepatitis control programme. (Action taken by Deputy Medical Superintendent – I)
3. Regular cleaning of AHU in the institution and there should be a unilateral flow of Air to OT, ICU, NICU/PICU and UV irradiation require in OT, ETC. (Action taken by SDO PWD/ Electrical).
4. There should a ambient temperature in OT, ICU, NICU /PICU. (Action taken by JE Electrical).
5. Repair of AHU and regular maintainance of AHU in paraclinical areas. (Action taken by SDO PWD/ Electrical).
